# NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME

## ABOUT

ON SEPTEMBER 24, 1969, THE THEN UNION EDUCATION MINISTER DR. V.K.R.V. RAO, LAUNCHED THE NSS PROGRAMME IN 37 UNIVERSITIES COVERING ALL STATES AND SIMULTANEOUSLY REQUESTED THE CHIEF MINISTERS OF STATES FOR THEIR COOPERATION AND HELP. IT WAS APPROPRIATE THAT THE PROGRAMME WAS STARTED DURING THE GANDHI CENTENARY YEAR AS IT WAS GANDHI JI WHO INSPIRED THE INDIAN YOUTH TO PARTICIPATE IN THE MOVEMENT FOR INDIA'S INDEPENDENCE AND THE SOCIAL UPLIFTMENT OF THE DOWN TRODDEN MASSES OF OUR NATION.

THE CARDINAL PRINCIPLE OF THE PROGRAMME IS THAT IT IS ORGANIZED BY THE STUDENTS THEMSELVES AND BOTH STUDENTS AND TEACHERS THROUGH THEIR COMBINED PARTICIPATION IN SOCIAL SERVICE, GET A SENSE OF INVOLVEMENT IN THE TASKS OF NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT. BESIDES, THE STUDENTS, PARTICULARLY, OBTAIN WORK EXPERIENCE WHICH MIGHT HELP THEM TO FIND AVENUES OF SELF-EMPLOYMENT OR EMPLOYMENT IN ANY ORGANISATION AT THE END OF THEIR UNIVERSITY CAREER. THE INITIAL FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS PROVIDED FOR AN EXPENDITURE OF RS. 120/- PER NSS STUDENT PER ANNUM TO BE SHARED BY THE CENTRAL AND THE STATE GOVERNMENTS IN THE RATIO OF 7:5 I.E. THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT SPENDING RS. 70/- AND STATE GOVERNMENTS RS. 50/- RESPECTIVELY PER NSS STUDENT PER YEAR. AN AMOUNT OF RS. 120/- PER NSS STUDENT PER ANNUM ON PROGRAMMES TO BE SHARED BY THE CENTRAL AND STATE GOVERNMENTS IN THE RATION OF 7:5 (I.E. RS. 70/- PER STUDENT BY THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT AND RS. 50/- PER STUDENT BY THE STATE GOVERNMENTS). NOW, THE NSS IS A CENTRAL SECTOR SCHEME OF GOVERNMENT OF INDIA AND TO RUN ITS ACTIVITIES & PROGRAMMES IN ALL THE STATES AND UNION TERRITORIES ARE FULLY FUNDED BY THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT. KEEPING THE INFLATION IN VIEW, THE BUDGET FOR SPECIAL CAMPING AND REGULAR ACTIVITIES IS AS FOLLOWS:
