# About National Service Scheme (NSS)

The The National Service Scheme (NSS) is a Central Sector Scheme of the Government of India, under the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports. It provides opportunities for students in 11th and 12th grades of schools at the +2 Board level, as well as students in technical institutions, graduate, and postgraduate levels at colleges and universities across India to participate in various government-led community service activities and programs.

The primary objective of NSS is to develop the personality and character of student youth through voluntary community service. "Education through Service" is the core purpose of the NSS.

NSS was launched in 1969 in 37 universities, involving about 40,000 volunteers. It has now expanded to cover 657 universities and 51 +2 councils/directorates, encompassing 20,669 colleges/technical institutions and 11,988 senior secondary schools. Since its inception, over 7.4 crore students have benefited from NSS.

# Postal Scheme Awareness Program






National Service Scheme unit recently held a



National Service Scheme in collaboration with Meenakshi Mission Hospital & Research Centre, Madurai, organized a Blood Donation Camp on October 3, 2024.











#### A MOMENT OF PRIDE

- \* Providing hands-on training on fire extinguisher usage and first aid.




